Hanley Eskins








Willow Marie Wilson of Mingo County was born on May 28th, 2025. Her parents are Jenna and Shane Wilson, and she is their first baby!


Raena Faye Priddy

My favorite foods are bananas, turkey, sweet potatoes, and green beans.


I can sit up, army crawl, walk in my walker, move my bouncer across the room, and say momma, dadda, and baba.


Serenity Grace Judith Newberry was born on March 18, 2025. Her parents are Nicole Goddard and Bryan Newberry of Culloden.






Daisy Mae Miller




