## DHHR Reports Dramatic Drop in Putnam Covid Cases

On June 1st, the DHHR reported 20 new Covid-19 cases in Putnam County between May 25 and May 31. New cases in the previous 7-day period was 63. The 20 cases is the lowest 7-day total reported since July 6, 2020, when 13 new cases were reported.

The number of active cases in the county also tumbled, going from 323 on May 25 to 241 on May 31. Putnam's active Covid cases were last below 241 on October 8, 2020, when the DHHR reported 230 cases. Putnam's active Covid cases reached a high of 849 on December 14, 2020.

Putnam's color on the DHHR Covid-Alert Map went from orange (high concern) to gold (moderate concern) to yellow (mild concern) to green (little concern) during the last seven days of May. Putnam's green designation on Tuesday, June 1, was determined by the percentage of tests registering positive for the virus. When first placed in use, map color was determined by infection rate (the number

of new cases per 100,000 population). Putnam's color on June 1, based upon infection rate, would have been yellow.

Tuesday's DHHR map had 34 counties showing green. Of the 34, only 13 registered a lower infection rate than Putnam. One week earlier, on May 24, the DHHR map had 46 counties displaying a better color than Putnam.

One factor which could explain Putnam's improvement in statewide rank from 47th to 14th in the space of seven days is the county's vaccination rate. Putnam's fully vaccinated rate is 38%. Statewide, only 14 counties have a higher percentage of fully vaccinated residents.

While Putnam's 38% is above the state average, medical experts believe that there will be a resurgence of new cases in the fall unless more than 60% are fully vaccinated.

## Eastern Star Chapter 116 Helps Reopen Genesis Center Courtyard

Members of the Eastern Star Chapter 116 of Hurricane recently helped spruce up the courtyard at the Genesis Putnam Center, which is located behind Teays CAMC. Due to the coronavirus pandemic, the residents of the nursing home were not allowed in the courtyard for over a year. Charles D. Raines was born July 23, 1904, in

Huntington. His father, James Edward Raines, was born March 11, 1869. His mother, Emma Jane Lambert Raines, was born on May 17, 1876. Charles was raised in Huntington. The family moved to Los Angeles, California for a few years. Charles and his brother, Lavoid, went to the University of Southern California. ## County Commission News

Sometimes routine agenda items at Putnam County Commission meetings prove to be not so routine. Such was the case at the March 27 County Commission meeting during and after the conduct of a public hearing requested by PAR Industrial Company. PAR requested the hearing after being notified in April that failure to repair a dilapidated fence located on Scary Creek Road could result in fines.

During the hearing, PAR attorney Tim Lafon argued that Putnam's Dilapidated and Abandoned Property ordinance should not apply because there was no reason to believe that the property was intended for human habitation and the property lacked any structure.

Tina Peck of the DAEA Board countered that the fence was a structure and that it was dilapidated. Lafon then asked if the property would be considered a stretch of

woods in the absence of the fence. Peck replied that removal of the fence would bring PAR into compliance with the ordinance.

Commissioner Ron Foster responded to the suggestion that the property was just woods. Foster stated that PAR's deed to the Scary Creek property made reference to its having been used by FMC chemical company as a dump site. Lafon objected to Foster's conclusion because 10

## Entries Sought for 2021 West Virginia Juried Exhibition

The West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History (WVDACH) is announcing a call for entries for its 22nd biennial West Virginia Juried Exhibition. The show will be on display at the Culture Center in Charleston. Since 1979, the exhibition has celebrated the exceptional talents and creativity of Mountain State artists.

Submissions for the exhibit in the form of digital images on CD or USB flash drive will be accepted through Monday, Aug. 2. Artists may submit two pieces for the exhibition with a limit of three digital images per entry. Entry forms and properly identified images must be accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$20 per piece. Make check payable to West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History. Digital images can be mailed to WVDACH, West Virginia Juried Exhibition (WVJE) 2021, The Culture Center, 1900 Kanawha Blvd., E., Charleston, W.Va. 25305-0300, or hand-delivered to the Culture Center at the State Capitol Complex. An option to email images will be available this year by first contacting Cailin Howe, exhibits coordinator, to ensure your images are submitted properly. Image file sizes must be small enough to be received through email, an entry form must be included, and entry fee will still need to be mailed to the department.

Eligible entries include works created in the past two years in the areas of painting, sculpture, printmaking, drawing, photography, digital art, mixed media and crafts.

Entrants must be over the age of 18 and must be residents of or maintain a permanent residence in West Virginia. Entrants also must complete a WVDACH Artists' Register form at <http://www.wvculture.org/museum/artsreg>.

html and submit six slides or digital images representative of current work for the file at the department. The images submitted for the Artists' Register are not used in jurying entries into the exhibition.

A prospectus for the exhibit is available online at <http://www.wvculture.org/museum/juried/2021/juriedexperspectous2021.pdf>.

The department will present up to \$33,000 in awards for the exhibition. The awards are made available through the West Virginia Commission on the Arts and the WVDACH through funds appropriated by the West Virginia Legislature and the National Endowment for the Arts. Awards may include three \$5,000 Governor's Awards (purchase awards), seven \$2,000 Awards of Excellence (purchase awards) and eight \$500 Merit Awards (non-purchase awards). Works receiving Purchase Awards become part of the West Virginia State Museum's permanent art collection.

The exhibit will open at the Culture Center with an awards ceremony and reception at 2 p.m., Sunday, Nov. 14, 2021, and remain on display through Feb. 14, 2022. The exhibit showcases the work of state artists and craftspeople and provides the public with a comprehensive view of art and craft activities in the state.

parcels of land were described in the deed and the bulk of the acreage was not in the vicinity of the area addressed in the complaint.

Foster then replied that people do not build fences for the sake of building fences and that the presence of a fence is cause to believe that people are not wanted on the property. Foster stated that there had to be a reason that PAR paid \$2 million for less than 100 acres of property in 1982 but the issue before the commission was the fence, not the land's past usage.

Commissioner Andy Skidmore asked Lafon what action that the

company planned take. Lafon replied that action by PAR would be dependent upon what the commission should order, that it was PAR's position is that there is no habitable structure on the property and the ordinance does not apply.

Foster stated that the code allows the county to address unsafe conditions and that the fence is an unnecessary hazard. The hearing concluded with the commission ordering PAR to correct the conditions cited in the DAEA complaint.

Immediately following the vote, however, a Scary Creek resident asked to address the commission concerning the fence and other issues on the property. The

resident informed the commissioners that the site had a long history of unpleasant odors and that he had seen a white substance seeping from the ground. The resident also reported that trash had been illegally dumped in areas where the fence had failed and that the area was known for drug activity. The resident stated that on one occasion, the fallen fence had to be removed from Scary Creek Road by the DOH.

Commissioner Foster asked County Attorney Larry Frye if any steps had been taken to determine if the area was an environmental hazard. Frye responded that he had requested a list of hazardous waste sites in the county from the DNR.

After assuring the resident that his concerns were in the process of being addressed, the commission returned to regular business.

Other business included approving a request to provide \$35,000 additional funding to the WVU Extension Office. The commission had budgeted \$25,000 to the Extension Office for the coming fiscal year. Commissioner Foster voted in opposition to the increase, stating opposition to initiatives by WVU President Gee to promote the expansion of curricula content

## Memorial Day— Last Monday in May

At the end of the Civil War there began a tradition. It was called Decoration Day. People would visit their cemetery and place a flower of remembrance of fallen soldiers over the years. When World War I came, it changed to encompass all soldiers who had passed in time of war. The name changed and people started referring to it as Memorial Day in the 1880's.

1971: Memorial Day, the last Monday in May, became an official holiday.

Wearing a red poppy on Memorial Day - in 1915, John McCrae was inspired by the Battle of Ypres to write the first three verses of "In Flanders Fields" that gives a voice to the fallen. Later a volunteer war worker named Monica Michael made an answer to the poem to give the living soldiers their voice, which are the last three verses of the poem. We shall keep to faith the poppy remains the symbol of remembrance to this day.

In Flanders fields the poppies blow  
Between the crosses, row on row,  
That mark our place; and in the sky  
The larks, still bravely singing, fly  
Scarce heard amid the guns below.

We are the Dead. Short days ago  
We lived, felt dawn, saw sunset glow,  
Loved and were loved, and now we lie,  
In Flanders fields.

Take up our quarrel with the foe:  
To you from failing hands we throw  
The torch; be yours to hold it high.  
If ye break faith with us who die



### Joshua Commands the Sun to Stand Still

Joshua 10:1-15

The book of Joshua is both history and scripture. As history, it is a record of the things which happened in the period following the death of Moses. As scripture, it is written for our admonition such that His will might be manifested in us (see I Cor. 10:11).

The text before us includes a record of a day unlike any other, a day in which God caused the sun to stand still. If asked why did God make this happen, many would state that the miracle allowed Israel to defeat the enemy. Very few would declare that God did it for our admonition. Both answers are correct. Believers know God by that which He does. God does that which He does for our understanding.

Consider the events leading up to the day in which the sun stood still. Adoni-zedek, the king of Jerusalem, and four other Armorite kings had gathered their armies against the city of Gibeon with the intent of destroying it because the Gibeonites had made peace with Israel (v. 4). The reason that the Gibeonites chose to make peace is found in Chapter 9.

The Gibeonites knew that the Lord God of Israel had commanded the children of Israel to take possession of the land and to destroy all its inhabitants. The Gibeonites had cause to believe that God would empower Israel to do as He had commanded. They had heard of that which God had done to Egypt. They had witnessed that which God had done to the two Armorite kings who ruled over the cities of Heshbon and Bashan on the east of the Jordan. They knew the likewise fate of the kings of Jericho and Ai on the western side of the Jordan.

The peace deal to which the Gibeonites agreed stipulated that they would become Israel's servants in exchange for a pledge before the Lord God that Israel would not slay them.

Returning to verse 4: Gibeon was now under siege by the five kings because the Gibeonites believed that God would do what God had said He would do.

Joshua responded to Gibeon's call for help (v. 7). Joshua could have reasoned that Israel was under no obligation to bring aid because the Gibeonites had falsely claimed that they were of a distant land. Joshua responded because Israel's pledge before God took precedence over Gibeon's deceit. Joshua's desire was to do that which was right before God.

God knows the hearts of men and He knew Joshua's thoughts. In verse 8, God assured Joshua that he was doing the right thing. Joshua attacked. Verses 10 and 11 describe that which God did. The Lord routed the five kings and inflicted casualties upon their retreating armies. Verse 11 states that the Lord slew more Amorites with hailstones than Israel did with the sword.

The scripture states that Joshua, standing in the sight of Israel, commanded the sun and the moon to stand still. Verse 13 states that the sun and the moon obeyed. Joshua commanded it and it happened. What? No man possesses the power to direct the sun and the moon. How did Joshua do it? Joshua did not make it happen. God did. Verse 14 states, "And there was no day like that before or after it, that the Lord hearkened unto the voice of a man." God caused what Joshua commanded to happen. The Lord God hearkened to the voice of a man.

Believers know that God does not answer to man. He was to slay every Armorite. Joshua achieved the new objective because the sun and the moon obeyed his command.

Joshua did that which he did in the sight of Israel. The power of faith is power from God. God gives His power to all who would do His will as Joshua did. God would have all men know that He empowers them who seek His will.

Let us use the faith which we have been given.





Clark Kessinger was among the most prolific and influential fiddlers of the 20th century

The following events happened on these dates in West Virginia history. To read more, go to e-WV: The West Virginia Encyclopedia at www.wvencyclopedia.org.

June 3, 1856: Harriet B. Jones was born in Pennsylvania. After attending Wheeling Female College and graduating from the Women's Medical College of Baltimore, she opened a private practice in Wheeling, becoming the first woman licensed to practice medicine in West Virginia.

June 3, 1861: The first land battle of the Civil War took place in Philippi. About 3,000 federal troops drove about 800 Confederates from the town.

June 3, 1861: A company of Confederate soldiers known as the Logan Wildcats was created at the Logan Courthouse. The company, consisting of about 85 men, first saw action at the Battle of Scary Creek.

June 3, 1936: The first Strawberry Festival was held in Buckhannon. More than 6,000 spectators attended the festivities, which also included a parade of 30 princesses down Main Street.

June 4, 1975: Clark Kessinger died in St. Albans, Kanawha County. Kessinger was among the most prolific and influential fiddlers of the 20th century, and one of West Virginia's most important traditional musicians.

June 5, 1859: A great frost killed crops in the Preston County fields. The fields were replanted with hardy buckwheat, which was successful and became a staple crop, celebrated in the annual Buckwheat Festival in Kingwood.

June 6, 1919: Historian

Otis Rice was born in Hugheston, Kanawha County. Rice was named West Virginia's first Historian Laureate in 2003.

June 6, 1989: During the Pittston strike, about 60 miners embarked on a four-day march from Logan County to Charleston, retracing the path of the 1921 Armed March on Logan.

June 7, 1899: Congresswoman Elizabeth Kee was born in Radford, Virginia. She became West Virginia's first female member of Congress in 1951.

June 7, 1926: An explosion at a sand mining operation in Morgan County killed six men. Their deaths were the inspiration for the ballad "The Miner's Doom."

June 8, 1893: Entrepreneur Donald F. Duncan was born. Duncan was the founder of the Duncan Yo-Yo Company and the Duncan Parking Meter Corporation.

June 9, 1927: Karl Dewey Myers was named the state's first poet laureate by Governor Howard Mason Gore. Myers held the post for 10 years.

June 9, 1957: T.D. Jakes was born in South Charleston. As a boy, he preached to imaginary congregations and carried a Bible to school, which earned him the nickname "Bible Boy." He is the senior pastor at the Potter's House, a nondenominational church in Dallas, Texas.
