publication The frequency of Covid articles in the Breeze slowed in 2021. The first issue published in both 2021 and 2022, however, featured Covid headlines. In 2021, the headline was "Putnam Red on COVID Alert Map" and in 2022, it was "Putnam Covid Case Numbers Soar."


In this, the first issue of 2023, it is time to look at Covid in the rear view mirror. Despite the closing of schools, Putnam's active case number hit a enjoy good health. high in early December

of 2020 with more than one thousand reported. reopened Schools statewide in January of 2021. The active case number dropped in the first half of 2021, bounced up and down and then surged from 215 on December 23, 2021 to 501 on January 4, 2022. Active cases in Putnam dropped to just 42 on May 9, 2022. The 2022 calendar year ended with the DHHR reporting 50 active cases in the county.

During 2020, 56 did not feature a Covid-19 Putnam deaths were attributed to Covid. The number of Covid deaths grew to 147 as 2021 ended. As of January 2, 2023, the county's Covid death total was 209.

> Putnam's total cases of Covid-19 from the onset of the pandemic was 20,000 on January 1, 2023. More than half (10,700) of this total was reported in 2022. There is evidence that the current strains of Covid do not produce severe symptoms in individuals in good health — even in the elderly who

Alumni, students, returnit to WVSU's Office faculty, staff, and friends of Alumni Relations. The of West Virginia State University (WVSU) can now pre-order a collegiate branded license plate from the West Virginia Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV).

The license plate contains WVSU's Stinger mascot and the university's name on a black and gold themed plate. The plates are only available for West Virginia residents. The design is not available for handicap, motorcycle, or RV license plates.

The DMV requires a minimum of 250 preorders by April 21, 2023, for the production of the license plates to commence. They are priced at \$95, which includes the tag fee and a small, non-refundable processing fee. There is no donation to the university included in the purchase. Individuals can purchase as many plates as they wish; however, plates need to be purchased and connected with a vehicle.

To pre-order, individuals must fill out a form from the DMV and

forms may be emailed to alumni@wvstateu.edu, or they can be mailed to Office of Alumni Relations, P.O. Box 1000, East Hall 100, Institute, WV 25112. The form can be found online at https://connect.wvstateu. edu/WVSULicensePlate/ order.

Those who pre-order a plate will be mailed a letter from the state about their license plate(s) and take that letter to the local county clerk's office to complete the process, pay any necessary fees, and receive the plate. It is anticipated they will be available by the end of 2023 if enough pre-orders have been successfully completed. The plates will not be mailed to residences.

women have it made back in the day with dad going to work, and mom staying home and keeping the home fires burning? Not mentioning the television shows where dad walks in the door and mom greets him in her cute dress, perfect hair and makeup, and high heels. (Thinking "The Donna Reed Show" and "Father Knows Best"...) Did women have more time to relax when they did not go out the door in the morning? Are we blessed with our modern appliances and our time to do the things we love? As to the high heels... those are gone thankfully.

I have no answer. I remember how great it was to stay home and raise Nathan and Kathy... Mike traveled often, and we could not wait for him to come home. I used to sit in a lawn chair watching for him, with the kids playing by my side. I know I stayed busy, busier than when I worked full time. Running the kids, cooking, cleaning, laundry... chores... I worked for the church as the secretary/clerk, and I volunteered at the church as ladies' teacher, the kids on Sunday nights, etc. Mike was a deacon, on the building committee, a Gideon, Sunday School Supt... etc... we were churched so much... plus he coached sports. We had baseball, soccer, basketball, swim team, dance classes... you name it... we were doing it... later, band... I babysat a couple of years for a little girl... all day... the days were full... we were tired by evenings...

I was a room mom every year for Nathan's class and/or Kathy's Class. I was VP of the parent/ teacher group which meant I was in charge of the huge fund raiser... I was into genealogy then also and a million crafts. You name it... we were doing something been easier on our family. often. I never thought That being said, I would about working full time have missed too much because where would I find the time? Eventually, I worked fifteen hours a week for a surgeon during the school year. We had Indian Guides and Indian Princesses through the YMCA... It seemed that there was something going on constantly. We cherished every day with our kids. We also had company often. One year, we had company 35 weekends. Big families... the cooking was fun... the cleaning up not so much. I would NOT miss one of those visits though. Loved having family and friends stay with us. One of the grands asked me what I thought was a great invention. My answer, "The microwave." I remember when I came home from the doctor's office, work, and there sat a huge microwave in the kitchen. It was so much easier to prepare food, especially during baseball season. I have often prepared meals in the microwave, not just warmed up. Still do so. Made my life better. I do know that when I became a teacher, I knew that there was no way I could have taught and raised the kids. I had to be hands on, and that would not have been possible. The same way when we owned the Hallmark Store... the kids were in high school and college and worked with us. If they had been smaller, no way

We did not have tons of money when we were raising our children. I know that if I had worked full time, it would have made it easier financially. However, we made the choice for me to stay at home. I do not regret that for one minute. It was the best life ever. My daughter and daughter in law have made the same choice. In fact, my daughter has home schooled her three girls. She and my daughter in law are the hardest working women I know. My daughter now works part time at the church and has for a few years. She also worked evenings at the library when the girls were small. Her teaching career ended when she had the first baby.

Several years ago, I was asked to speak to the church we helped build in Ohio. I told the congregation, "You are sitting on padded pews that we charter members sacrificed to purchase. You are sitting in a church that was built with money our families gave ... we ate lots of macaroni and cheese... lol... However, the house we lived in is now gone... the car is gone... the things are gone ... those items do not last. This church is still standing... still going strong. I do not regret one dollar that we spent... be thankful and remember those of us who went before you... we had a vision... we believed in it... with God's help, we accomplished it. Do NOT take this church for granted. Do not make it a place to entertain and play... keep it a place of worship ... " I also told them that because I was a worrier, my husband almost had to drag me to the bank to sign one of the notes to build the church. They enjoyed that thought... I know if I had been working full time, again... it would have with the kids. Did we have it better? I have no clue. I love my life. I have loved almost every year of my life. There were some difficult times that I could have done without. However, if one doesn't live in the valley, how can the mountain be great? I have become stronger living through adversity. If I had never had that, would I be the woman I am today? Would those I love know this Nana who lets nothing get her down? This mom/nana who laughs so much. The boys call this the laughing place... Nana's condo. I am sure the neighbors want to chuckle when they see me on the tennis court, the pickle ball court, playing badminton ... when sometimes, I can't walk properly... or when I sit by the pool with my daughter... not getting in... I struggle with physical issues, but I keep going... just like the little Energizer bunny does. I don't let anything stop me... I don't know if life was better "back then"... but I know it is sure good now... family... children, spouses, grands... living for them is what matters to me... they make my life better because the way we were is the way we are. I cannot answer the question I received. I do not know if it is better or not... I know that I am happy and blessed.





Turkey Meatballs:

- 6 ounces 99% lean ground turkey
- 1/4 cup whole-wheat breadcrumbs
- 2 tablespoons fat-free evaporated milk
- 1 tablespoon grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/2 tablespoon fresh chives, rinsed, dried and chopped
- 1/2 tablespoon fresh parsley, rinsed, dried and chopped

Beef Meatballs:

- 6 ounces 93% lean ground beef
- 1/4 cup whole-wheat breadcrumbs
- 2 tablespoons fat-free evaporated milk
- 1 tablespoon grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/2 tablespoon fresh chives, rinsed, dried and chopped
- 1/2 tablespoon fresh parsley, rinsed, dried and chopped

Preheat oven to 400 F.

In 4-quart saucepan over high heat, bring water to boil.

Add pasta and cook according to package directions. Drain and set aside.

To make turkey meatballs: In bowl, combine ground turkey, breadcrumbs, evaporated milk, Parmesan cheese, chives and parsley; mix well. Measure 1 1/2 tablespoons turkey mixture and roll into ball using hands. Place meatball on nonstick baking sheet. Repeat until eight turkey meatballs are made.

To make beef meatballs: In separate bowl, combine ground beef, breadcrumbs, evaporated milk, Parmesan cheese, chives and parsley; mix well. Measure 1 1/2 tablespoons beef mixture and roll into ball using hands. Place meatball on nonstick baking sheet. Repeat until eight beef meatballs are made.

Bake meatballs 10 minutes until minimum internal temperature of 165 F is reached.

Warm sauce, if necessary.

To serve: Serve four meatballs with 3/4 cup pasta, 1/2 cup sauce, 1 teaspoon Parmesan cheese and 1 pinch basil per portion.

to the physical realm, applies to the spiritual. One is either in the light or in the darkness. In verse 5, the Holy Spirit moved John to state that God is light and there is no darkness in Him. With God, there are no shades of gray. To enjoy fellowship with the Father and the Son, one must be without darkness. Any who experience gray are far from the light and the joy of fellowship with Him.

An individual can say that he has fellowship with the Father and the Son — that he experiences the fullness of joy of the fellowship of knowing Jesus — but that does not make it so. Darkness has no fellowship with light. In verse 6, John describes all who falsely claim to walk in the light as liars. The fellowship that one enjoys with the Son is a fellowship of light.

The gospels reveal that John enjoyed a close relationship with Jesus, perhaps closer than any other apostle. Yet, in verse 8, John says, "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us." John, in employing "we," includes himself among those who have failed to reflect the light of the Father and the Son. When we sin, our fellowship with the Son and with one another is destroyed because darkness cannot reflect light.

In verse 9, John declares that Jesus Christ the Son of God is faithful and just to forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. When we repent and ask Jesus to forgive us our sins, He cleanses us. The sin which prevented us from reflecting the light of our Savior is washed away and our fellowship with Him and with one another is restored.

John addresses "My little children" in the opening verse of chapter 2. Little children are different from young men and from fathers (see v. 13). Little children have not overcome the wicked one. Little children have not known Christ from the beginning. Little children are subject to the fiery darts of the wicked and need help in spiritual warfare. John describes little children as individuals who have known the Father.

All believers know the Father through the Son. We know the Son through the scriptures. John reveals that we (little children, young men and fathers) have an advocate, Jesus Christ the righteous, who satisfied the sin debt of the whole world (v. 2). How did this happen? What are the dynamics? God made it happen. Christ was foreordained before the foundation of the world to be slain as a lamb without blemish or spot (I Pet. 19-20). God the Father, through God the Son, gave Himself to suffer death for them who believe as Abraham believed (see Gen. 15:6). The same God who gave Himself to die for us has appointed Christ the righteous to be our advocate.

Who is Christ the righteous? Christ is He who prayed to the Father asking, "... keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are" (Jn. 17:11). The desire of the Father is made known to us through the Son. The Father raised the Son from the grave to be our Advocate. He who counted Abraham's faith for righteousness, has provided an advocate for all who believe as Abraham believed.

Little children know the Father as the God who so loved them that He gave His only begotten Son to die such that they should have eternal life (Jn. 3:16). John (who knew the Son from the beginning) desires that all should know that the Father has provided an advocate who is faithful and just to forgive us when we confess our sins. 
JC was a "lover" of life, travel, photography, and most of all, his family. James was a

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
