# West Teays Students **Get Firsthand View** of City Government

Second grade students from West Teays in number to attend the Hurricane City Council meeting on Monday, February 6, to watch government in action. They witnessed a meeting which included a little bit of everything.

The meeting opened with a presentation of a plaque to former Street Department head Lee Campbell who recently retired with 22 year's service.

The students next witnessed reports from the Police Department, Fire Department, City Manager, and Director of City Marketing and Development.

The Police Department reported 28 arrests in response to State charges and 6 City arrests during the month of January. Two of the City arrests involved possession of Meth. The CIU (Criminal Investigation Unit) seized 17 pounds of marijuana and \$5,667 in cash in addition to the 10.5 grams of Meth.

Fire Chief Michael Hoffman informed council that he expects the new fire station to open on April 1st. The \$6 million facility will allow the City to

City Manager Andy Skidmore announced that electrical work at the Elementary turned out new fire station would be completed by February 10. Skidmore said that the weather has caused delay in getting the sand and soil mixed for the football field at Bridge Park. Thor Meeks recognized as the 2022 Young Leader Award for his contributions to the Meeks Mountain Trail, but also for his leadership within the Putnam County Chamber of Commerce and as a local business owner.

Meeks Mountain is a trail system project that began in November 2018 with a mission to build and sustain a network of trails for the health and well-being of the people and create additional opportunities for economic growth. Due to the abundance of willing volunteers, we anticipate having a trail system that covers 26 miles in the near future, possibly more. We

## West Virginia Celebrates 211 Day

Saturday is 211 Day, celebrating the go-to resource 211, which helped 30,520 people in West Virginia access help for immediate or longterm challenges last year.

Throughout 2022, trained call specialists connected people to locally available services, including help with rent, food, utility bills and health care. For example, there were 15,581 referrals for utility assistance, 7,949 referrals for rent assistance, and 3,503 referrals for shelters and other programs for the unhoused.

211 is a free, confidential, 24-hour information and referral service that connects West Virginia's residents with health and human services support. Anyone in need of help or information can call 211 or text 898-211 to reach a trained 211 Community Resource Specialist. In 2022, the service received 26,140 phone calls, 2,174 live chats, and 1,696 texts from people in all across the state.

April Knight, State Director of West Virginia 211 is encouraging people to use the service.

"People reached out to 211 this year to find information on basic needs, like heating or utility assistance, elder care, or to find the closest food bank. They also called for everyday information like where to take their child for developmental screening or how to locate job training or find free tax filing support," Knight said.

211 has helped a number of people, including a caller who needed help with an electric bill which was more than 1 month of their household income. After speaking with the caller a little more, the 211 Community Resource Specialist learned of other needs and was able to connect the family with programs to help with the electric bill and also resources for coats and shoes for the children, blankets for the family, and toys for Christmas.

A vast amount of local information is available through the service, including health and mental health resources, health insurance programs, support for older Americans and people with disabilities, adult day care, Meals on Wheels, respite care, home health care, transportation, homemaker services and support for children, youth, and families.

West Virginia 211 is supported by the United Way offices located throughout the state.

Starting on Feb. 11, 211 is currently available to 99% of people in the U.S. and across all of Canada.

Remembering... It has been almost three years since Linda lost Rodney; it has been almost three years since my son-in-law lost his dad; it has been almost two years since we Burkes lost Marshall. Difficult to believe, to imagine these three great men gone from our lives. We loved all of them.

I remember Rodnev from high school, a sweet, quiet, kind boy... when he and Linda married, they and Mike and I became good friends... she and I had been friends forever... I remember going out to eat at Bennigans in Charleston or eating at Gino's pizza. Going to reunions with them; going to their lovely home after those reunions that were okay... I did enjoy seeing old friends. I remember celebrating their anniversaries... celebrating Linda's 40th birthday at Pizza Hut... her 50th and again her 60th and 70th... big ones... sorry, Linda... I remember bridal and baby showers for Lisa and Amy... those babies all grown up now with babies of their own.

One time, I remember we were at a shower at the Methodist Church. It was freezing outside. Rodney walked up to us and told Linda, "Don't go outside until I get the car warmed up." I was so flabbergasted. Since Mike traveled so much, and I took the kids to school, I was used to cold cars. I went home and told Mike about it. He was surprised also... that was Rodney. Cherishing that wife of

I remember once when they came to our store in Summersville to shop...the four of us, after we closed, went to get pizza. Afterwards, Mike looked at me and said, "They truly love each other forever... a true love story." That is the way it was... they, like Mike and I, grew up together. Mike was 17 and I was almost 16 when we got together. Unfortunately, we only had 30 years. Linda and Rodney had more than 50...They were blessed... we were blessed to know them together. Sadly, Larry, the girls' granddad died in his sleep in 2020... suddenly... unexpectedly...a wonderful man taken too soon. One grand was studying in England and had to fly home... later, came home because of Covid, of course. His was the last funeral I attended before the big C (Covid) hit... Larry was so unique, funny, a great family man. He and Janet married in their teen years. He was in a family of 12 or 13 children. Larry was the only one married and he was a teenager... imagine raising that many kids... (I adored Larry's mother...) Pat's mom had stuffed animals made from some of the clothes of his dad... they all love those memories. She also gave them some of his sweatshirts which they wear, even the girls...and

Daddy took it pretty hard and left home for a while, but did

not stay away. Will, as he was known at home, told about he and Clyde Hall hauling wagon loads of tobacco to auction at the tobacco warehouses in Hurricane. He was a charter member of the L.O.O.F. Lodge #295 in Hurricane, and a member Sycamore Baptist Church. Daddy eventually left the farm and became a butcher, working in the company stores for various coal mining companies. While working for the Collins Mining Co. in Fayette County, WV he met Lillie Brash, b. September 23, 1893, daughter of John and Susan Hepburn Brash





Prep time: 60 minutes

### Caramelized Onions:

- tablespoons butter tablespoons olive oil
- 3 large yellow onions, halved, sliced 1/4-inch thick
- tablespoons water (optional)
- tablespoon brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon balsamic vinegar
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 1/8
- teaspoon pepper
- teaspoon red pepper flakes

#### Sandwiches:

- large sourdough slices, 1/2-inch thick 1/3cup mayonnaise
- ounces fresh goat cheese, at room temperature
- ounces shredded gruyere cheese, at room temperature
- jar Aunt Nellie's Sliced Pickled Beets (about 32 beets)
- 2 cups baby arugula
- 2 tablespoons butter, divided
- tablespoons olive oil, divided

To make caramelized onions: In Dutch oven over medium-high heat, melt butter and olive oil. Add onion and cook, stirring occasionally, 5 minutes then reduce heat to medium. Cook until onions are caramelized and rich, deep golden brown, about 25

minutes, stirring often. Turn heat to medium-low or add water if onions are dry or start to scorch before caramelizing. Add sugar, balsamic vinegar, salt, pepper and red pepper flakes; cook 1 minute.

Onions should be jammy and darkly caramelized when done. Remove to plate To make sandwiches: Spread out bread slices on flat surface. Spread thin layer

of mayonnaise on one side of each bread slice. Turn four bread slices over and spread goat cheese on plain side. Top goat cheese with gruyere, even layer of beets, caramelized onions and arugula. Top with remaining bread, mayo side out. Secure with toothpicks, if desired.

In large skillet over medium-low heat, melt 1 tablespoon butter with 1 tablespoon olive oil. Add two sandwiches, cover and grill until bottom of bread is toasted, about 5-7 minutes, and cheese starts melting, checking often. Flip and cook, uncovered, until cheese is melted and bottom of bread is toasted.

Repeat with remaining sandwiches.

## 3-Bean Tortellini Minestrone

Recipe courtesy of "Joy of Eating"

Prep time: 20 minutes Cook time: 25 minutes

- can (15 ounces) READ 3-Bean Salad
- 1/2cup extra-virgin olive oil 1/2medium yellow onion, diced
- peeled garlic cloves, minced 3
- 2 pinches salt, plus additional to taste, divided teaspoon Italian seasoning 1
- 1/4
- teaspoon black pepper, plus additional to taste, divided small carrots, trimmed, peeled and diced
- 3 2 celery stalks, trimmed and diced
- 1 medium zucchini, diced
- 1 can (28 ounces) diced tomatoes, undrained
- 1 Parmesan rind (optional)
- 6 cups low-sodium vegetable broth ounces refrigerated cheese tortellini 9-10
- cups baby spinach
- jarred pesto, for serving (optional)

Drain and rinse bean salad; set aside.

In large pot over medium heat, heat olive oil. Add onions, garlic and 1 pinch salt;

saute until translucent, 3-4 minutes. Stir in Italian seasoning and 1/4 teaspoon black pepper. Cook until fragrant, about 1 minute. Add carrots, celery and zucchini with remaining pinch salt. Cook, stirring occasionally, until vegetables are crisp tender, 5-7 minutes. Stir in tomatoes. Add Parmesan rind, if desired. Cook about 10 minutes

until most tomato juice evaporates. Pour in vegetable broth. Bring to boil. Add tortellini; cook 2 minutes, or just until tender. Stir in bean salad and spinach. Cook 2-3 minutes to heat through.

Season with additional salt and black pepper, to taste. Serve garnished with pesto, if desired.

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
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# A TEST OF TIME

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# **BASIC BIBLE**

## **Blessing of Godliness**

II Peter 1:3-14

"According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:" The verse before us is a reminder of that which God has done and His purpose for so doing. His divine power is not separate from God. He is Divine Power. The Creator of all has given us all things that pertain to life and godliness. Life is eternal life and godliness is godly living.

These words were penned by Simon Peter. This epistle is a record of Peter's last words. He would soon suffer death by crucifixion (see v. 14, Jn. 21:18-19). The Lord Jesus Christ rose from the dead and was seen of Peter and many others some thirty years before this epistle was written. On the third occasion in which the Lord appeared to the disciples, He spoke to Peter saying, "Feed my sheep" (Jn. 21:15, 16 and 17). Let us feast upon the meal which Peter has set before us.

In verse 3, the apostle reminds us (His sheep) that God has called us to glory and virtue. In the English language, glory serves as both a noun and a verb. The Greek word which Peter penned is *doxa*, a noun alone. It means a glory which is of God. It is an awesome glory, a glory which radiates upon all who hear His call and come to Him. The virtue to which we are called is, likewise, of Him. He has given us exceeding and great promises.

In verse 4, Peter states why God has given us such marvelous and wonderful promises. The Lord God of all would have us partake of His divine nature. He would have us experience the fullness of knowing Him. Peter is writing to "us." Us is all who escape the corruption that is in the world through lust. There is only one means of escape. No man can save himself from himself. Us is all who have called upon the only name by which men may be saved. Us is all who have been saved by grace through faith. Saving faith is the gift of God (Eph. 2:8). We have escaped the corruption which lust wields by believing upon Him who paid our sin debt.

"And beside this" (v. 5). His great and precious promises exceed the gift of saving faith. Saving faith is not an end. It is the beginning of knowing God. Faith removes the barrier that separates man from God. Through diligence, we can add virtue, knowledge, temperance, patience, godliness, brotherly kindness, and charity. Through diligence, we are able to experience the divine nature. Diligence requires us to pay attention to the tasks before us.

Virtue is listed first because everyone can distinguish between good things and bad things. When one receives a good thing, one is moved to respond. New believers respond to that which has been given to them by doing things which are pleasing to God. We know to live for Him who died for us.

Some new believers are diligent and some are not. Those who fall by the wayside do so because they lose sight of that which Christ has done. Peter wants what God wants. Peter wants us to remember always that which Christ has done. The apostle wants us to build upon the knowledge that Jesus has made us free from sin.

Building knowledge requires diligence. In a classroom setting, one cannot learn if one does not listen to the teacher. One must push distractions aside. Jesus went to be with the Father so that the Comforter would come and teach us all things (Jn. 14:26). The diligent hear and come to know Jesus more fully.

Temperance is built upon knowledge because it requires appropriate response to the freedom which Christ has purchased. Temperance is action tempered by knowledge of His righteousness. Partaking of the divine nature involves acting upon knowledge.

Patience involves waiting for opportunity. It is temperance in action. Patience produces the right action at the right time.

To patience we are to add godliness. Godliness simply means to do things


God's way. Virtue, knowledge, temperance and patience all combine to manifest God.

To godliness we are to add brotherly kindness. Peter lists qualities in sequential order. Brotherly kindness can be evident in the homes of pagans. Brotherly kindness speaks to them who lack knowledge of God.

And to brotherly love we are to add charity. Charity is a selfless love. It is a love that goes beyond brotherly love. Selfless love is the ultimate expression of Jesus Christ. It is the fullest portrayal of the divine nature

to which we are called. If these things abound in us, we shall be fruitful. His purposes will be

realized through us. God is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. God has called us to deliver that message. In so doing, we are to make our calling and election certain. Let us do as He has said. Let us never forget that which He has done.
