## City of Hurricane Levy Election June 13

City offices will be closed to business on Tuesday, June 13, but the Hurricane Municipal Building will be open to all residents who choose to exercise their right to vote.

Tuesday is Election Day for Mayor, Recorder, and City Council and for a Special Levy Election which, if approved, will authorize the current excess levy to be extended through the 2026-2027 fiscal year.

No election outcome is official until the votes are counted, but the ballot for office lists only members of the Citizens Party. The Citizen Party met on March 24, 2023, and nominated Scott Edwards for Mayor; Linda Gibson for Recorder; Steve Goff, Marshall Ginn, Gerry Spears, Reggie Billups, and Al Howard for City Council. No other party held a nominating convention and no independent candidates filed.

The current special excess levy was first approved more than 70 years ago and has been renewed by voters in election after election.

Tuesday's election will be historic in that it will mark the last ever Municipal Election or Special Levy Election which not in conjunction with a regularly scheduled National Primary or General Election.

Prior to this year, Hurricane officials were elected to 4-year terms. Those elected on Tuesday will serve until December 31, 2026. The next Hurricane city election will coincide with the November General Election in 2026.

The extension of the city's Special Excess Levy will result in its being placed upon the 2026 Primary Election ballot. The West Virginia legislature enacted legislation last year requiring special elections to coincide with a primary or a general election.

## Monday on Main Brings Food Truck Delight





## Agriculture Commissioner Calls For Celebration of Dairy Month

Commissioner of Agriculture Kent Leonhardt and the West Virginia Department of Agriculture (WVDA) are calling on residents of the Mountain State to support local dairies and connected industries during National Dairy Month. Originally established in 1937, National Dairy Month is held annually in June to highlight the impact of the dairy industry in the United States. West Virginia currently has 32 dairy farms, two dairy processing plants and one aseptic dairy processing plant.

"We don't often stop to think about the dairy products we eat each day," said Commissioner Leonhardt. "From milk to ice cream, creamer for our coffee to the cheese we put on our tacos, dairy is a big part of our diet. West Virginia dairy farmers are helping feed our families. With the addition of Mountaintop Beverage, West Virginia's dairy industry has a unique opportunity to grow. This Dairy Month, I encourage you to get to know your local dairy farmer."

The WVDA, Farm Credit of the Virginias, Horizon Farm Credit, Mountaintop Beverage and the American Dairy Association Mideast, on behalf of West Virginia dairy farmers, are sponsoring Dairy Days at GoMart Ballpark in Charleston on Friday, June 9, and at the Monongalia County Ballpark in Morgantown on Friday, June 16. There will be various dairy

products available and some fun activities. The Department is also asking the public to support West Virginia dairy by purchasing local ice cream, cheese and other byproducts.

"Since the Department took over the full regulation of milk and dairy products in West Virginia, we have worked with our producers to reduce regulations and foster innovation. As dairy consumption has plateaued in the United States, producers must look towards niche markets to connect with consumers. Our goal is to help valued-added industries, such as cheese production, and traditional dairy processing flourish in West Virginia," Leonhardt said.



### Yellowfin Tuna and Artichoke Pasta

Prep time: 15 minutes

Cook time: 40 minutes with fresh artichokes (25 minutes with canned)

Servings: 4

#### Artichokes:

- Cold water
- 12 small, fresh artichokes or 2 cans artichoke hearts in water
- 2 lemons
- 3 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- salt, to taste
- pepper or red pepper, to taste

#### Pasta:

- Water
- 2 cans (5 ounces each) Genova Yellowfin Tuna in Olive Oil
- 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- 4 tablespoons butter, cut into tabs
- 4 cloves garlic, chopped
- 1 teaspoon crushed red pepper (optional)
- salt, to taste
- 1/2 cup white wine, chicken stock or vegetable stock
- 1 pound spaghetti or linguine
- 1 lemon, juice only
- 1 cup grated Pecorino Romano cheese
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh Italian parsley, divided
- 1 small handful fresh mint, chopped, divided
- 1/4 cup toasted pistachios or pine nuts, chopped

To make artichokes: Preheat oven to 425 F.

Fill bowl with cold water and juice of one lemon.

If using fresh artichokes, trim tops of artichokes and tougher outer leaves. Using vegetable peeler or small paring knife, trim stems. Once prepped, cut fresh artichokes in half. If using canned artichokes, drain well and quarter lengthwise.

Place artichokes in lemon water.

Let soak 2-3 minutes, drain and pat dry with kitchen towel.

In casserole or baking dish, arrange artichokes and add juice of remaining lemon, quarter lemon and add lemon wedges to dish.

Add olive oil and salt and pepper, to taste.

Roast 25-30 minutes, or until tender.

To make pasta: Bring large pot of water to boil.

While water is coming to boil, place large skillet over medium heat and add olive oil and butter. Add garlic; red pepper, if desired; and salt, to taste, and swirl 1 minute. Add white wine or stock and let reduce by half.

When water comes to boil, salt water, add pasta and cook 1 minute less than directions. Reserve 1/2 cup pasta water before draining.

Add artichokes to large skillet with tuna with its oil and gently break up with back of wooden spoon or paddle.

Add lemon juice and reserved pasta water to skillet along with drained pasta, cheese and half the parsley, mint and pistachios. Toss to combine, top with remaining parsley, mint and pistachios and serve.

### Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Vouchers Available

Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Vouchers are now available at senior centers in all 55 counties in West Virginia. Vouchers are distributed by the West Virginia Department of Agriculture (WVDA) through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP). Vouchers can be exchanged for fresh, nutritious, unprepared, locally grown fruits, vegetables, honey and herbs from participating farmers markets, roadside stands and community supported agriculture programs.

"Changes in this year's program will allow even more senior citizens to take part. That means more, fresh, West Virginia grown food will make it into the hands of those who need it the most," said Commissioner of Agriculture Kent Leonhardt. "This program is a win/win for everyone involved. The seniors benefit from better nutrition and our West Virginia farmers and growers are being paid for the products they grow."

Eligible seniors age of 60 and over can sign up at their local senior centers. Vouchers are distributed to seniors who meet certain requirements. In 2022, 16,800 vouchers totaling \$504,000 were handed out to low-income West

Virginia senior citizens who qualified for the program. Each voucher was worth \$30. This year, 17,800 vouchers worth a total of \$890,000 will be available. Each voucher will be worth \$50 towards the purchase of fresh produce.

"The Department works with a lot of great partners around the state to distribute these vouchers. If someone has a question or wants to check their eligibility, don't hesitate to reach out to a local senior center or the department," Leonhardt said.

## BASIC BIBLE

### A Perfect Kingdom

Matthew 5:17-18, 21-22, 27-28, 38-39, 43-44

In the text before us, Jesus continues to address the multitude which had gathered to hear His teaching. The multitude, like any gathering of people, could be divided into two groups — one which would enter into the kingdom of heaven and one which would not enter into the kingdom of heaven.

In verse 17, Jesus prefaces what He is about to say with the words: "Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill." Not everyone present would believe this statement. One group would come to believe that He had come to destroy the law, while the other would believe His words. At issue is entry into the kingdom of heaven. Those who would believe Jesus would enter in; those who would not believe would be on the outside.

Jesus stated that He had come to fulfill the very law that He would be accused of destroying. Jesus came to fulfill both the law and the words of the prophets.

Verse 18: Every detail of the law would remain in effect until all be fulfilled. Two thousand years have come and gone since Jesus spoke to those gathered on the mount. Today, there remain two groups: those who believe and those who do not. Believers know that all prophecy has not been fulfilled. The Messiah has yet to rule from the throne of David in Jerusalem. The issue which separates believers and non-believers is Jesus' fulfillment of the law.

In verses 21 and 22, Jesus addresses God's judgment as it relates to the actions and motives of men. All who listened to His words knew that according to the ten commandments that a murderer would face God's judgment. Jesus states that evil thoughts and evil words toward another are subject to the same judgment that a murderer would face. With God, the act of murder, the desire that unjustified harm fall upon another, and the utterance of hurtful words are all the same. God's judgment extends beyond the letter of the law; it looks upon the heart of all who would and do harm others.

That which applies to evil thoughts and murder also applies to thoughts of adultery and commission of adultery. Jesus reveals that fulfillment of the law encompasses more than outward compliance. Fulfilling the righteous requirement of the law requires one to follow the intent of the law. In verse 38, Jesus addresses a misuse of scripture. "An eye for an eye, and tooth for a tooth" appears in Exodus 21:24 and is repeated in Leviticus 24:20 and Deuteronomy 19:21. The context in each instance is that one's wrongdoing will be dealt with fairly. The scripture was not given with the intent that one wrongdoing should justify another's wrongdoing. Jesus instructed his listeners to resist hitting back when hit and to return evil with good.

In verse 43, Jesus quotes both scripture and the words of men. The children of Israel were commanded to love thy neighbor as thyself (Lev. 19:18). This is scripture as given to Moses. The addition, "and hate thine enemy", is not scripture. Deuteronomy 23:3-6 could possibly serve as a basis for the teaching of men to hate thine enemy. In this scripture, the children of Israel are instructed to remain separate and apart from a specifically named enemy and not to engage in practices which would enable that enemy to prosper. But the general teaching of hatred of one's enemy clearly conflicts with Proverbs 25:21 in which God's people are instructed to give food and drink to their enemies.

In verse 44, Jesus makes it known that we as God's people are to love our enemies, are to bless them who curse us, are to do good to them who hate us, and are to pray for them who spitefully use us and persecute us. God's people are called to extend love to them who would bite the very hand that feeds them. We are called to reach out with love to them who would purposely abuse us.

The justice system of men is based upon fairness, while the justice system of God is based upon love. In the halls of justice erected by men, there is no requirement for us to love enemies or to do good to them who injure us. This requirement, however, has been placed upon us by our Lord and Savior, Christ Jesus. Why? Because this is what God does and we are to be like God our Father who art in heaven. God judges men with the fairness of His love. Christ Jesus died for us while we were yet sinners. God extended His love to us, the undeserved. Fairness with God is that we extend love to others as He has extended His love to us.

The enemies of God curse Him. The enemies of God hate Him when He reaches out to them with goodness.

We, as His children, are to be perfect as He is perfect. His love is perfect. What is perfect love? His love is without condition. Maps showing the location of rights-of-way to be maintained are available for review upon request.

Right-of-way maintenance agreements between Appalachian Power and landowners are available to landowners who prefer to accept responsibility for clearing the right-of-way crossing their property instead of the company's aerial application of herbicides. The agreement compensates the landowner by an amount equivalent to the cost of aerial herbicide application, provided the work meets Appalachian Power's specifications. Landowners desiring to enter right-of-way maintenance agreements with Appalachian Power should call the toll-free number above.

Herbicides to be used have been extensively tested and are registered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the West Virginia Department of Agriculture. They are glyphosate, imazapyr, metsulfuron methyl, fosamine, triclopyr, aminocyclopyrachlor and aminopyralid. All applications are performed by certified applicators.
