## County Commission Approves Courthouse Paving Bid

## Old Time Power on Display at Farm Museum Antique Tractor Pull

It was bid opening time for the Putnam County Commission at its May 28 meeting. Brian Estep of Silling Architects (project designer) unsealed bids from West Virginia Paving and Asphalt Contractors and Site Work Inc. for paving the parking areas at the courthouse in Winfield.

Both companies submitted a base bid with accompanying alternative 1 and alternate 2 bids. WV Paving's bids came in high at \$415,325; \$17,640; and \$175,140. Asphalt Contractors submissions were \$269,959; \$13,480; and \$108,810.

The commission awarded the contract to Asphalt Contractors and Site Work pending staff review of the company's submission.

In other business of note, the commission voted to reinstate R-1 Residential zoning to a parcel on Mount Vernon Road which abuts both commercial and residential properties near the Sheetz location on Teays Valley Road. The rezoning was challenged in circuit court because the re-zoning hearing was not properly advertised. State law requires notices of such hearings to be advertised as Class II legal notices (published twice

with one week between publications) thirty days prior to the meeting. The first publication met the thirty day requirement but the second publication did not. Judge Philip Stowers ruled that both publications needed to meet the 30-day requirement.

Commissioner Brian Ellis made the motion to restore the R-1 zoning after stating that an appeal would be more time consuming than restarting the process from the beginning.

The commission approved a request by the Putnam County Health Board to implement state-approved fee increases in stages. Health Board Director Crystal Moberly stated that the health department expenditures could be met with smaller than approved fee increases.

The commission recognized Hurricane Middle student Quintin Williams for winning third place honors in County Commissioners Association of West Virginia's annual essay contest. The CCAWV issues cash awards to first, second and third place essays on the how the actions of county commissions benefit their counties.

The next county commission meeting will be Tuesday, June 11, at 9 a.m.

The West Virginia Farm Museum in Point Pleasant held an antique tractor pull last Saturday, June 1. The pull featured a variety of antique tractors in action. To be considered an antique, a tractor must be from 1959 or earlier.

Upcoming events at the West Virginia Farm Museum include a double elimination bracket pull this coming Saturday, June 8. This will be the first time that the museum has hosted

such an event. The pull is for tractors of the 5,250-lb class, and features payouts of \$200 for third place, \$300 for second place, and \$500 for first place. The event starts at 11 a.m., and there will be a rain date of July 13.

There will be another antique tractor pull on July 6 at 1 p.m., and a tractor parade and show on July 27. The tractor parade, which starts at noon, will travel seventeen miles around the Point Pleasant area.

## Hurricane Man Sentenced for Defrauding Odd Fellows

Paul Richard Spurlock, 67, of Hurricane, was sentenced Monday, June 3, to eight months in prison, to be followed by five years of supervised release, and ordered to pay \$106,500 in restitution for bank fraud. Spurlock admitted that he embezzled approximately \$106,500 from a fraternal organization's historic charitable care home by using his position as its board's treasurer.

According to court documents and statements made in court, the Grand Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows - West Virginia had operated the Home in Elkins beginning in the early 1900s. Over its history, the institution provided housing and care

for orphans, widows, seniors and people with disabilities. Spurlock had been the treasurer of the home's board of directors for several years when he lost his seat on the board in October 2018. Spurlock admitted that from on or about July 8, 2015, to on or about January 22, 2019, he embezzled approximately \$106,500 from the Odd Fellows Home. Spurlock falsely told his wife, who was acting as the home's bookkeeper, that the home's board of directors had approved a loan for their family.

Spurlock admitted that as part of his scheme, he caused an unauthorized check for \$4,000 from the Odd Fellows Home's account

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## Putnam County Bank Sports Complex Opens at Hurricane Bridge Park

Friday, May 31, was a big day for Hurricane's Bridge Park as the Putnam County Bank Sports Complex marked its opening with a ribbon cutting. The complex features a central concession stand with restrooms and a press box surrounded by four all-weather turf baseball fields.

The need for such a facility has long been evident. Ball field use at City Park at the Hurricane Reservoir reached capacity years ago. Hurricane Mayor Scott Edwards said that city officials knew the need twenty years ago but lacked the resources to provide a remedy.

The city took the first step to cure overcrowding in 2015 by purchasing 42 acres which stretched from Midland Trail near Hurricane Middle School to the creek behind First Baptist Church on Main Street. The 42 acres was hardly ideal. It was divided into two sections by Big Hurricane Creek.

The city chose to develop

the section near Midland Trail because of easy access. Development of the upper section near First Baptist was put on hold. City planners determined that access from Main Street was an absolute necessity. Rights-of-way, a new road and a bridge over the creek behind the church would be costly but necessary bumps in the road.

The city employed GAI Consultants to submit park designs. In 2021, the city purchased an additional 23 acres making it necessary for GAI to start over. The additional acreage made a full cloverleaf of fields possible.

Funding for development became possible by including the park in the Hurricane TIF district (tax incentive financing district). With funding, the project accelerated.

Putnam County Bank provided the boost needed to finish construction of the central concession/press

to be issued to his wife on January 22, 2019, and deposited into their shared Huntington bank account. Spurlock further admitted that he signed at least 33

unauthorized Odd Fellows Home checks made payable to his wife and deposited into their joint account, and used an authorized signatory's signature stamp on each check without his wife's knowledge.

The Odd Fellows Home closed and was auctioned off in 2022 because of financial difficulties.

United States District Judge Robert C. Chambers imposed the sentence.

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



### Deborah Encourages Barak

Judges 4:4-10, 12-16

At this time, the children of Israel were in the land that God had promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. At God's direction and with God's assistance, Joshua had defeated the inhabitants of the land and driven them out. God had removed every obstacle which could prevent them from prospering in the land of milk and honey. So what happened? The children of Israel disobeyed the first commandment. They forsook the God of their fathers and followed after gods of the people around them.

Chapter 4 begins with the words: "And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of the Lord". It was not the first time nor would it be the last time that Israel should do evil in God's sight. Each time that Israel followed after other gods, God strengthened their enemies and empowered them to subjugate Israel. In this instance the enemy is Jabin king of Canaan who reigned in Hazor.

This is not the first Jabin king of Canaan to rule from Hazor. Approximately 150 years earlier, Joshua totally destroyed the city of Hazor and executed Jabin. The Lord raised up an enemy from ashes for the express purpose of punishing His disobedient children. The Lord would have His people learn from history rather than repeat it but they were slow to learn that they were to serve no god but the Lord God.

Jabin was able to force his will upon Israel because he possessed a military advantage that the Israelites could not match or defend against. He had 900 chariots of iron. Compared to other metals of use in this era, iron was indestructible. It was also not commonly available and difficult to fashion into weaponry. Jabin maintained his hold over Israel for twenty years until God raised up a judge to deliver them.

God chose Deborah for this purpose. She was a prophetess and judge over all Israel (v. 4). She was not self-appointed. She was made a prophetess by God and given words which Israel recognized to be from the Lord. Acting upon that which the Lord said, she sent for Barak who dwelt in Kedesh-Naphtali. Deborah resided under the palm tree of Deborah which was approximately a straight-line distance of seventy miles to the south. Barak came because he knew that God spoke through Deborah. She asked him if the Lord had not instructed him to gather ten thousand men from the tribes of Naphtali and of Zebulun. Her question revealed to Barak that she knew that God had spoken to him and she knew the battle plan that the Lord had given to him.

When God spoke to Barak, he was not certain that it was God who had spoken. Upon hearing Deborah repeat the Lord's words, Barak believed. He responded that he would do as the Lord had instructed on the condition that Deborah would accompany him. Barak believed that God had spoken and he believed that God was with Deborah. He was not certain, however, that God would be with him in battle. Barak needed assurance. Commentators often expound upon the frailty of Barak's character because he would not do as God had instructed unless Deborah would go with him. The book of Judges reveals that Gideon, the military leader who followed Barak, also required a sign that God was with him. Gideon asked for two signs (Judg. 6:36-40).

Deborah responded to Barak that she would go with him but that the honor of slaying Sisera, the commander of Jabin's army, would belong to a woman. Barak then gathered up ten thousand men as God had instructed.

The Holy Spirit moved the human author to record Judges 4 in such manner so that we might comprehend the fullness of what God did and how He did. God did much more than defeat an enemy which boasted of nine hundred chariots of iron. God defeated a superior fighting force with a lesser force, a force led by an individual who was unwilling to lead unless Deborah was at his side.

It cannot be said that Barak was unqualified to lead. His name is listed among the heroes of the faith in Hebrews 11. His name is there right beside Gideon's. God would have us understand that the heroes of the faith were all individuals encumbered with weaknesses. They were individuals who, in spite of their weaknesses, acted upon faith. When men act upon faith in God, God provides the victory. Barak, unwilling to trust in his own strength, acted upon the faith. Barak believed that with Deborah's support that he could do as he was directed.

While Barak was God's chosen military leader, Deborah was the undisputed leader of all Israel whom God had chosen. When she sent for Barak, Barak came. Whenever Deborah was faced with a decision, she was quick to respond. When Barak said that he would go if Deborah accompany him, she immediately responded that she would go. Deborah did not consult with an advisor (not even her husband). She did not consult with the Lord. She was fully touch in with Him. In responding to Barak's request that she go, Deborah issued the prophecy that Sisera (the captain of Jabin's army) would be delivered into the hand of a woman. These words were given to her by God the very instant Barak expressed his condition.

Barak executed God's battle plan in the precise manner which the Lord prescribed. God gave the victory, every man of the enemy fell (v. 12-16).

Both elements of Deborah and Barak are present in New Testament believers in that there are times in which we know with certainty (as with Deborah) that the Holy Spirit leading and times in which we need added assurance (as with Barak) that the Spirit is speaking.

When certain, we are to share our certainty. When uncertain, we are to seek assurance from those whom God has spoken. Let us act. The Lord is a rewarder of all who trust in Him.

- New EE/DR rates, effective January 1, 2025 and for the next three rate years, of 0.001853 cents per kilowatt-hour for residential customers and 0.000225 cents per kilowatt-hour for commercial and industrial customers.
